*Metropole* records the effect of the booming value of property in London by using double exposures to document its numerous new corporate and luxury residential buildings as they are constructed and occupied. As the series progresses these structures merge and overlap, becoming increasingly disorientating and threatening, emulating the feeling of finding oneself lost in a once familiar city.

First published in March 2015 as a book which garnered international attention and rapidly sold out, this exhibition at Central House is the first exhibition of the entire *Metropole* series as well as being the first event of INSIDE / OUT [LONDON], a program of exhibitions of photobooks examining the contemporary city, curated by Andy Lawson. A new print of the *Metropole* book will also be available during the exhibition.






Untitled, from *Metropole* (2015)
